Llamas, sometimes called "camels of the clouds," are essential to the indigenous people in the high plains of Peru, Bolivia, and Ecuador. They are hardy pack animals that require little water and can carry heavy loads over long distances. Llamas also supply wool, hides, candle fat, and manure pellets for fuel. Heifer's Women Artisans in Peru Project helps local craftswomen learn the fair market value of their creations, adopt clear standards for alpaca yarn and dyes, and connects them directly to buyers so they don't lose income to middlemen. Heifer has been working in Peru since 1963 and has helped 890 craftswomen through the Women Artisans Project. Participants also receive veterinary medicine kits for their alpaca herds, marketing support, and training in business management.

Help us make Erin Church look like Peru! We are in need of Latin American decor – brightly colored rugs, blankets, baskets, artwork, figurines, anything with embroidery or tassels – to decorate for VBS.
