Muchas Gracias!

Thank you to all the volunteers who helped make *Passport* to *Peru VBS* an amazing experience for our children.

Eighteen kids attended VBS this year. Ten Adult leaders and 14 Youth helpers led the kids in Music, Snack time, Bible story, Games, and the Experience Peru stations. The children learned all about the culture of Peru, Spanish words for their numbers and colors, played games the children in Peru play, and sampled patatas (potatoes), canchita (popcorn), and arroz con leche (rice pudding). They also learned that God gives us comfort, patience, peace, and love.

The children were very excited about the Mission Project: Heifer International. They learned all the ways that a llama contributes to the livelihood and well being of the peoples of Peru, and they were determined to raise at least \$150, the cost of gifting one llama to a need family. The children and their families were very generous with their offering and collected a total of \$230. \$ 150 will be donated to Heifer, to gift a llama, and \$80 will be given to the Women Artisans of Peru Project.
