Yes, goodness and faithful love


will pursue me all the days of my life,

THE APOSTLES' CREED

Leader: Family of faith, children of God, what do we believe?

All: We believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ his only Son our Lord;

Leader: who was conceived by the Holy Ghost, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified dead, and buried;

All: he descended into hell; the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and sitteth on the right hand of God the Father Almighty;

Leader: from thence he shall come to judge the quick and the dead.
